DISCIPLINARY and APPEALS PROCEDURE

IN OPERATION FROM 1St JUNE 2005

The Appeals Committee shall hear the appeal against the Level 2, Level 3 or Level 4 decision and/or penalty within 7 days of its' appointment. The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding on all parties. A Individual or Team/Club is entitled to legal representation at the appeal on the proviso that all the legal fees and costs relating thereto shall be met by the appellant Individual or the Team/Club.

When an appeal is made pursuant to the condition set out below, then an Appeals Committee will be appointed by the Executive Committee.

- a) The Appeals Committee will consist of 3 people to be appointed by the Executive Committee. No member of the Appeals Committee will be a member of the Disciplinary Committee, who set the penalty, or a member of the Club or Clubs concerned in the appeal. The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding.
- b) The Appeals Committee shall allow the appeal if it considers that the original Disciplinary Committee decision is unreasonable or cannot be supported by the evidence presented, but in all other cases shall dismiss the appeal.
- c) On appeal against a penalty imposed by the Disciplinary Committee, the Appeals Committee, may, if it thinks that a different penalty should have been imposed, quash the original penalty and impose another Penalty Level (whether more or less severe) in substitution thereof as it thinks should have been applied.

DISCIPLINARY OFFENCES LEVELS

IN OPERATION FROM 1st JUNE 2005

Level 1 Offences

Abuse of equipment, clothing or any part of the ground.
Showing dissent at an umpire's decision by word or by action.
Using language or a gesture that is obscene, offensive or insulting.
Excessive appealing.
Aggressive gesticulation by a member of the fielding side.

Level 2 Offences

Repeat of any Level 1 Offence within 12 months.
Showing serious dissent at an umpire's decision by word or action.
Public criticism of a match-related incident or match official.
Inappropriate and deliberate physical contact between players during play.
Aggressively charging towards an umpire while appealing.
Deliberate distraction or obstruction on the field.
Throwing the ball at a player, umpire or official in a dangerous manner.
Using language or a gesture that is obscene, offensive or of a serious nature to another player, umpire, team official or spectator.
Changing the condition of the ball in breach of Law 42.3.
Any attempt to manipulate a match in regard to the result, net run rate, bonus points or otherwise.

Level 3 Offences

Repeat of any Level 2 Offences within 12 months.
Intimidation of an umpire.
Threat of assault on a player, team official or spectator.
Using language or gestures that offends race, religion, colour, sexual orientation, descent or national or ethnic origin.

Level 4 Offences

Repeat of any Level 3 Offences within 12 months.
Threat of assault on an umpire.
Physical assault on another player, umpire, team official or spectator.
Any act of violence during play.
Using language or gestures that seriously offends race, religion, colour, sexual orientation, descent or national or ethnic origin.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

The Executive Committee shall have the power to issue and/or amend the Codes of Conduct, Levels of Offences and Penalties in respect of the behaviour and conduct of all teams and individuals taking part in organised cricket in the Island of Jersey, and shall have the right to deal with all complaints against such teams and individuals, providing the complaints are made in writing to the Secretary within 7 days of the incident occurring (a faxed copy is acceptable). Ideally the Secretary should be advised verbally, within 3 days of the incident occurring, of the intention to send an incident report.

The Executive Committee will take no action, except in exceptional circumstances, if a written report is not received by the Secretary within 7 days of the incident.

The Executive Committee shall set up a Disciplinary Committee, which will consist of three people, within 7 days of the complaint being received. A Chairman will be nominated by the Executive Committee. The Disciplinary Committee will meet within a further period of 7 days to investigate any such complaint. No member of the Disciplinary Committee will be included who is associated with a Club/s or in the incident concerned in the disciplinary case.

The Disciplinary Committee shall advise the individual/team of their decision and, if appropriate, the level of penalty to be applied within 7 days of their meeting.

Any individual/team has the right of appeal against any penalty applied.

Clubs are responsible for their members actions both during matches, as players or spectators and in addition, at functions run for or by the Jersey Cricket Board, or their Club.

The Disciplinary Committee shall decide which Level of Offence is appropriate and apply the appropriate Penalty for that individual/team.

APPEALS

Please note that Level 1 Offences – the Disciplinary Committee's decision is final and binding on the Individual and his Team/Club.

Level 2, Level 3 or Level 4 Offences – A Player or Team/Club may lodge an appeal with the Jersey Cricket Board who will appoint an independent Appeals Committee to hear the appeal.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 4 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalty for Level 1 Offences

The offending player will receive a written warning.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 1 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalty for Level 2 Offences

The offending player will be banned from all cricket in Jersey for a period of 14 days from the date of the decision of the Disciplinary Committee.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 2 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalty for Level 3 Offences

The offending player will be banned from all cricket in Jersey for a period of 28 days from the date of the decision of the Disciplinary Committee.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 3 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalties for Level 4 Offences

The offending player will be banned from all cricket in Jersey for a period of anything from 3 months to life at the discretion of the Disciplinary Committee, depending on the gravity of the offence.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 4 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

IN OPERATION FOR THE 2006 SEASON**

Penalty for Level 1 Offences

If a Team's players are found guilty of three Level 1 Offences in a season, then on the third occasion the Team will be deducted 10 Weekend League points or 5 Evening League points, depending on the competition in which those offences were committed. A further deduction of 10 Weekend League points or 5 Evening League points will be made for each subsequent Level 1 Offence committed in that season by that Team's players in the competition in question.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 1 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalty for Level 2 Offences

If a Team's players are found guilty of two Level 2 Offences in a season, then on the second occasion the Team will be deducted 20 Weekend League points or 10 Evening League points, depending on the competition in which those offences were committed. A further deduction of 20 Weekend League points or 10 Evening League points will be made for each subsequent Level 2 Offence committed in that season by that Team's players in the competition in question.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 2 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalty for Level 3 Offences

For each Level 3 Offence a Team will be deducted 40 Weekend League points or 20 Evening League points, depending on the competition in which those offences were committed.

The Disciplinary Committee shall have full discretion to impose suitable penalties for Level 3 Offences committed in knock-out competitions, JICC and Inter-Insular matches.

Penalties for Level 4 Offences

For each Level 4 Offence a Team will be deducted 80 Weekend League points or 40 Evening League points, depending on the competition in which those offences were committed. In addition, the Team may be expelled from the relevant competition at the discretion of the Jersey Cricket Board Executive.
